

### Success Stories

Charlotte Evans and Lauren Jukes achieved a Grade 9 in English Language and English Literature respectively. This places Charlotte in the top 2% and Lauren in the top 3% of students in the country. This is even more impressive when placed in the context of the new, tougher 9-1 GCSEs in English Literature, English Language and Maths.

Charlotte achieved eight A\* grades and two A grades whilst Lauren achieved four A\*s, five As and one B grade.

Further success stories include Ryan Johnson and Taylor Woolley: Ryan achieved six A\*s and four A grades and Taylor achieved four A\*s and six A grades. All four students will be continuing their education at the prestigious King Edward VI Sixth Form College in Stourbridge.

### Highlights

- 48% of our Biology students and 48% of our Chemistry students achieved A/A\* grades.
- 34% of our Child Development students achieved A/A\* grades.
- 26% of our Drama students achieved A/A\* grades.
- 82% of our GCSE German students achieved a Grade B or above, which is 36% above the National Average.
- 68% of our PE students achieved a Grade B or above, which is 27% above the National Average.
- 54% of our GCSE English students achieved Grade 5 or above.
- 100% of our ECDL, Financial Capability and GCSE Polish students achieved a Grade C or above.

Biology, Chemistry, Core Science, Computing, Financial Capability, German, PE, Drama, Polish, Child Development and Dance performed significantly above the national average.

Additional Science, Physics, Music, French and Catering were also above the national average.

Attainment was enhanced in English Literature, Maths, Geography, History, RE, Business Studies and Art.
