Course Content Outline (What Will I study?)	<p><b>Unit 1—Devising from Stimulus 30%</b> In this Unit you will be given a stimulus. You will work in groups to create your own performance in your chosen style. You will then perform this to an audience and will gain a mark for your acting skills.</p> <p>You will keep a performance diary and evaluation which will also be marked, showing that you can justify the decisions you made during the rehearsal process.</p> <p><b>Unit 2 - Performing from text 30%</b> You will study a play and pick 2 scenes from this text to perform to an audience. you will be marked on your acting and a short written paragraph which explains the reasons for your chosen acting style.</p> <p><b>Unit 3—Written Exam 40%</b> You will complete a written exam with 2 sections. Section 1 will ask you questions about a play that you have studied. Section 2 will ask you questions about a piece of Live Theatre that you have seen.</p>
