



## St Michael`s Contribution to the Local Offer

The framework below sets out the expectations for the levels of support pupils and parents can expect to receive at:

**Universal level** – the level of provision the school offers to all pupils including those who may have special educational needs, funded via the age weighted pupil unit(AWPU)

**SEN Support** - A more personalised provision offered to pupils who have SEN, funded via the school`s SEN Notional Budget

**EHC Plan/Statement Support** – A highly personalised provision to support the needs of pupils with EHC Plans or Statement, funded via top up funding from the high needs block
